In order for your child to be registered with our club and the sports governing body the English Ice Hockey Association (EIHA) you will need to return the following forms.

3. Lee Valley Junior Ice Hockey Club Medical Consent Form
4. Lee Valley Junior Ice Hockey Club General Agreement

6. Lee Valley Junior Ice Hockey Club Shirt Order Form (only needed for team players)

You will need to provide a photocopy of your child's FULL British birth certificate (showing place of birth and nationality of parents) or a photocopy of their British Passport which must show where the player was born in order to validate their eligibility to play in the league and in the assigned age group. If the player is not British and/or has been previously registered to play ice hockey in a different country, some additional paperwork is required. These additional forms are not included in this pack. If you think that this may apply to you, please contact our registrations secretary who will be able to advise and supply the additional forms.

Lee Valley Lions Club Fees

Lee Valley Junior Ice Hockey Club runs as a 'not for profit' organisation. We set our fees as low as is possible.

Club fees are currently £720 per year. This can be paid annually or by 12 monthly payments (via standing order) of £60 per month.

The fees are used for general administrative cost associated with running the club such as ice time rental, payments to match day referees and officials provided by the EIHA.

English Ice Hockey Association Fees (EIHA)

Annual registration with the EIHA is mandatory for all players once they are training with the teams. This covers official registration into the EIHA (allowing the playing of matches) and insurance.

U9's - £30 per year

U11's - U18's - £60 per year

The 'Registration Pack' contains the relevant forms that should be completed at the end of each season (June/July) and submitted to the registrations secretary with payment so they can be processed in readiness for the beginning of the following season.

Due to EIHA guidelines we cannot register/transfer players with arrears on their accounts. If you require further information regarding this or your account, please contact the treasurer.



Training Times

All players **MUST** be on the bench, kitted and ready to start at the beginning of each session.

- Players must attend training on a regular basis with their age group in order to be eligible to play games.
- Players may be invited to 'train up' with an older age group if agreed with/by the coaches.

Home Games

All players must be present at the rink at least one hour before game time and fully kitted up, ready to get on the ice at least 30 minutes before. A charge of £5 (payable on the day) is required from each player to help cover the costs of these games.

Away Games

Players **MUST** attend away matches in order to qualify to play home games. So please do everything possible to ensure your child can play. If you have transport difficulties please speak to your relevant team manager who will assist.

All players should attend all games in their team hoodies.

Goalie/Netminer kit is considerable different form the list above. Please speak to the goalie coach before purchasing any goalie kit.

The club keeps a small stock of spare equipment for training sessions but where no spare is available, the player will not be allowed on the ice for safety and insurance reasons.
